

MASTER GARDENERS OF MADISON COUNTY HORTICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the Master Gardener scholarship program is to provide financial assistance to a high school senior, whose permanent residence is in Madison County, and has declared the intent to study horticulture or a related subject, such as botany, landscape architecture, agriculture, animal sciences relating to horticulture, forestry, natural resources, and environmental sciences. The scholarship will be awarded according to the following guidelines:

1. A high school senior, entering an accredited college or university, majoring in horticulture or a related subject area.
2. Lacking a qualifying high school senior applicant, previous recipients, beyond the first year, in good standing with the college they are enrolled in, and who are continuing in an acceptable major, will be considered.
3. Award of scholarship will be made without regard to race, color, sex, religion, handicapping condition, or national origin. The student must be a United States citizen.
4. More than one scholarship may be awarded in any given year.
5. Applicant must provide proof of college acceptance upon award notification.
6. In judging applicants, the following points will be considered:
 1. Essay on reason for choosing horticulture or related college major.
 2. Teacher(s) / Counselor recommendation
 3. Character
 4. Personality
 5. Leadership
 6. Scholarship – preference for students in the upper third of their graduating class.
7. A scholarship committee of the Master Gardeners of Madison County will review the applications. Personal interviews may be required, as determined necessary by the scholarship committee. If the committee determines there are no qualified applicants, the award may be withheld.
8. Additional applications may be obtained from the Madison County Purdue University Cooperative Extension Service office, located in the Madison County Government Center. Applications are due in the County Cooperative Extension Service Office by 4:00 p.m. on the last business day of February, for the school year beginning the following September.
9. The number and amount of awards will be determined annually by the board of directors of the Master Gardeners of Madison County. Whenever possible, this determination will be made by June 30th for the following year's award.

The scholarship award may be used for tuition, fees, and room and board at school-operated facilities.
